# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at French Bay Yacht Club.
- **1.4** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

# 2 ADVERTISING

**2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

# 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The MANUKAU SHIELD REGATTA is open to all daggerboard, centreboard and windsurf classes.
- **3.2** Eligible boats may enter online at: <u>FBYC Online Shopping</u> before 4pm Friday 1st April.
- **3.3** Late entries will be accepted at registration on the day <u>up until 9am</u> with the payment of a \$5 late entry fee.
- To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by Yachting NZ.

### 8 THE VENUE

Sailing will take place on the Manukau Harbour off-shore from French Bay Yacht Club.

# 9 THE COURSES

This will be confirmed in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions and notified at the briefing.

# 10 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for all classes.

# 11 SCORING

- **11.1** The Manukau Shield will be awarded to the highest placed Manukau yacht club according to the Manukau Shield scoring system.
- **11.2** Series for individual fleets will be scored as follows:

When <u>fewer than five</u> races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When <u>five</u> races have been completed, a boat's series score will exclude her worst race score. One race is required to constitute a regatta.

### 12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
