SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Attachment A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing
(page 136 RRS 2017-2020).

RULES

SSI 1 Additional regatta specific rules are set out in **NoR 1**.

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

SSI 2 The race office is located in the French Bay Yacht Club clubhouse. Notices to competitors will be placed on the official notice board outside of the clubhouse.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

SSI 3 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at the Rigging Deck

SSI 4 A boat shall not leave the shore until flag D is displayed. The warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after flag D is displayed or not before the scheduled time, whichever is the later.

SCHEDULE OF RACES AND CLASS FLAGS

SSI 5 It is the intention to sail **four** races, conditions and circumstances allowing.

SSI 6 The warning signals for a subsequent race on the same day will be made as soon as practicable but not sooner than 5 minutes after the last boat finishes the previous race for that class.

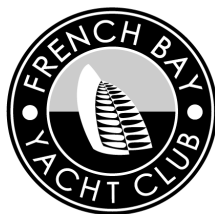
SSI 7 The Class flags will be the class insignia normally on a white background; class flags will be described at briefing.

COURSES

SSI 8 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Attachment A.

SSI 9 The course number to be sailed will be signalled from the committee boat on a board before the warning signal for each race.

MARKS

SSI 10 The course marks will be large diameter cylindrical yellow marks, cylindrical orange marks, and spherical pink marks (See attachment A). The start pin will be a spherical pink mark. The finish will be between a Surtees fishing boat and mark 4 (see attachment A) with a blue on station flag.

THE START

SSI 11 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least one minute before a warning signal is made.

SSI 12 A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.1.

TIME LIMITS

SSI 13

Target time for first finisher	Finish Window	Race time limit
30 minutes	10 minutes	60 minutes

There is no prescribed time limit for the first boat to pass mark 1.

FLEETS AND SEPARATE STARTS

SSI 14 The constitution of fleets with their own starts will be decided at the discretion of the PRO and notified to sailors at the briefing.

PENALTY SYSTEM

SSI 15 For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

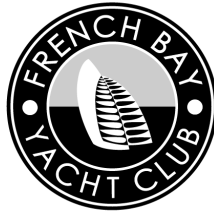
CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

SSI 16 Competitors shall sign on when going afloat and sign off once back on shore without delay at the FBYC Club house.

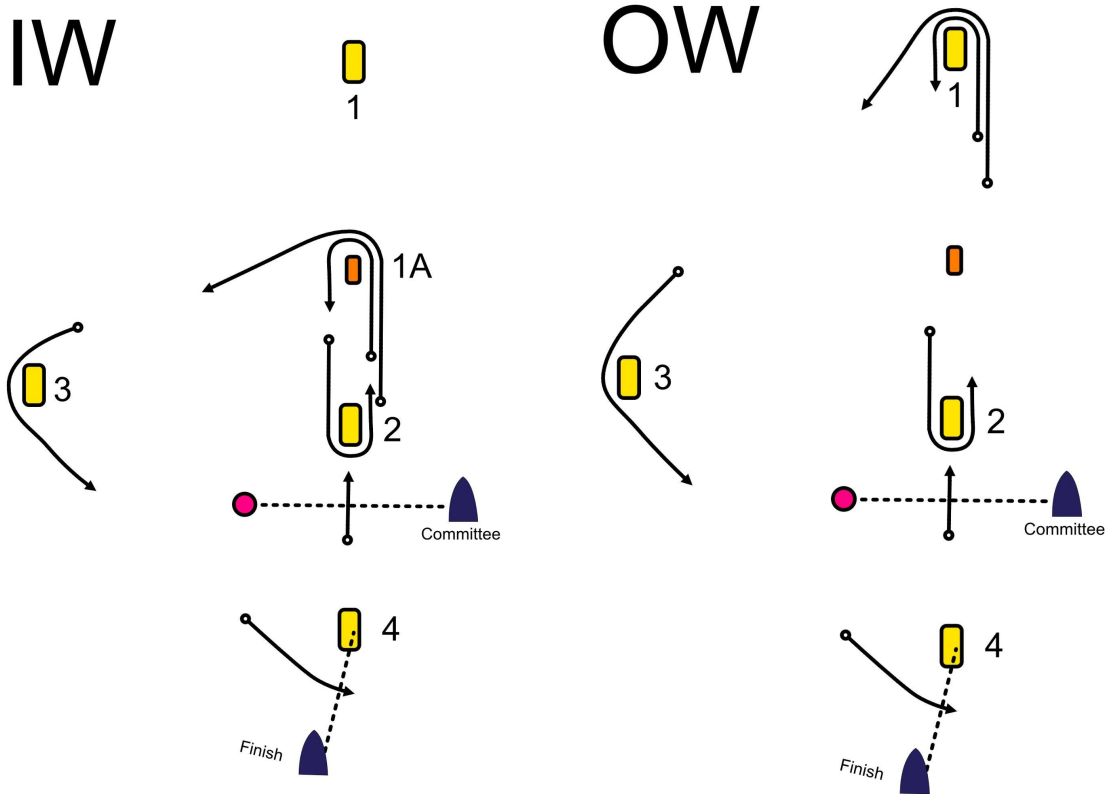
